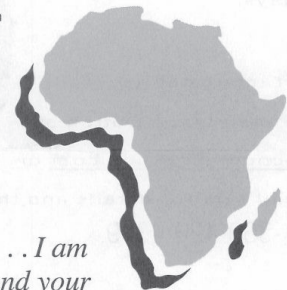
Speaking of tracts, and we send out thousands of these (!), a letter from a 16 year old in Ghana reads:
