Opportunities to Serve

Choir

The Worship Choir ministers during both of our West Side Sunday morning services, special events, and seasonal productions. Our goal is to point others to Christ through our ministry in worship.

Band/Vocal Team

The Vocal Team serves on the ‘front lines’ with a passion for His presence and leading others in worship. Vocalists are members of the Worship Choir and sing on a rotation basis. Vocal Team singers are strong vocally and demonstrate the ability to lead with humility and sensitivity.

The Worship Band consists of a rhythm section (piano, keyboard, drums, bass, acoustic guitar, and electric guitar) and other support pieces that play for weekend services, special events, and seasonal productions. Members must be able to read chord charts and improvise on their instrument.

Worship Signers

Worship Signers minister during Sunday morning services as part of the Worship Team. Their ministry provides services to our deaf community and helps to enhance the overall expression of our ministry of praise and worship to God. Signers must be gifted and trained in sign language and be anointed for worship ministry.

Rehearsals

Faith Worship Choir and Vocal Team members currently rehearse on the first three Thursday evenings of every month, in David's Court. Choir rehearsal begins promptly at 7:00 pm. You must attend the rehearsal on Thursday evening in order to sing in the choir that weekend. If you are unable to be at the Thursday evening rehearsal, simply take that weekend off, sit in the congregation, and come back to the choir the following week.

Faith Worship Band currently holds rehearsals on Saturday afternoons at 3:00 pm, prior to the Saturday evening service.

Call Times

Saturday evening call time is 3:00 for Band and Vocal Team.

Sunday morning call time is 7:15 am for the 8:30 band and 9:30 am for the vocal team, band and choir of the 10:30 service.

Worship Community must...

1. Be on time for rehearsals.
2. Take care to return to the backstage for prayer prior to service.
3. Be ready for choir and band entrance times.
4. Be prepared to return as a band after the message.
